- **Section 5.21**, pages 41 and 42, "Table 5: Summary of Indoor Illuminance Levels"  
**Replace** the published Table 5 with the revised Table 5 contained in the hard copy errata sheets supplied with the purchased document. Anyone using a hard copy of RP-6-01 purchased prior to June 2010 that lacks the errata sheet inserts should request them free of charge from the IESNA.
- **Section 6.4**, second sentence, bottom of page 43. This sentence **should read**:  
"An arrow is shot with a bow across distances of 18.3 to 91.5 meters (60 to 300 feet) to a target that is 0.91 to 1.83 meters (3.0 to 6.0 feet) in diameter."
- **Section 6.26.1**, lower half of page 61. The last sentence in this section **should read**:  
"See **Section 6.5** and **Figure 54**."
- **Section 6.28.1**, middle of page 62, under "Class IV – Parks and recreational"  
The item "( $E_{\max}/E_{\min} = 2:5$  or less)" **should read**: "( $E_{\max}/E_{\min} = 2.5:1$  or less)"
- **Section 6.31**, top of page 65, third bullet-dot item (Broomball). The section reference given at the end of this item should read: "(see **Section 6.16**)."
- **Section 6.32**, pages 65, 66, and 67, "Table 7: Summary of Outdoor Illuminance Levels"  
**Replace** the published Table 7 with the revised Table 7 contained in the hard copy errata sheets supplied with the purchased document. Anyone using a hard copy of RP-6-01 purchased prior to June 2010 that lacks the errata sheet inserts should request them free of charge from the IESNA.
- **Annex A**, top of page 70, in "(**Equation A5**)"  
The value CU' **should read**: CU'  
(the apostrophe immediately after CU should be a prime symbol)
- **Annex A**, bottom of the right-hand column on page 71, under "Vector Method"  
The expression that comes after "i.e.," **should read**:  $\vec{a} = (a_1, a_2, a_3)$   
No Greek letter "γ" should appear between  $a_2$  and  $a_3$
